

Thank you to all our Providers who continue to submit your Meal and Attendance claims each month. It is very important that all Providers, who are open, continue to submit their claims each month, even if you have only one child or a few meals to claim.

PY 20-21 ELIGIBILITY APPLICATIONS RENEWAL FOR JULY 1, 2020

Eligibility Applications were mailed on July 10, 2020 to providers who:

- Live in a Tier 1 area and previously (in PY 19-20) submitted an Eligibility Application and qualified to claim own, foster or other residential children under the age of 13 years.
- Live in a Tier 2 area and previously (in PY 19-20) submitted an Eligibility Application and qualified for Tier 1 reimbursement and claim own, foster or other residential children under the age of 13 years.
- Live in a Tier 2 area and previously (in PY 19-20) had the parents of the children in their care complete Eligibility Applications.

Please read all instructions carefully. Completed Eligibility Applications are due in our office on or before July 24, 2020. **All applications must be dated on the date completed in July 2020.** Applications with errors, write-overs, scratch-outs, etc. will be returned to the provider or parent for corrections. Applications received after July 24, 2020 could mean a loss of reimbursement money for the provider. **Don't delay in completing your Eligibility Applications and mailing them to our office before July 24, 2020.**

FEDERAL ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR PY 20-21 (July 1, 2020 to June, 30 2021)

If you have not previously qualified to claim own children **OR** live in a Tier 2 area and feel your income is now within the guidelines below, **OR** if your household receives Cal Fresh, Cal Works, FDPR; please call the office and request an Eligibility Application before July 22, 2020.
