

CACFP Reimbursement Rates Effective July 1, 2021 - June 30, 2022

USDA issued an eligibility waiver which reimburses ALL family child care providers at the Tier 1 rate for one year effective July 1, 2021.

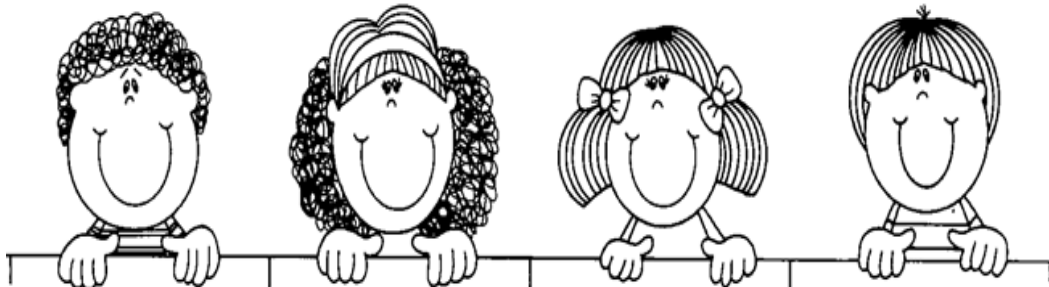
- Effective July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, all providers living in a Tier 2 area will be reimbursed at the Tier 1 rate (higher rate).
- If you are a provider living in a Tier 1 area, you will continue to receive Tier 1 rates (higher rate).

UPDATING ENROLLMENTS FOR CHILDREN STARTING KINDERGARTEN OR TK (TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN) AND CHILDREN STARTING FIRST GRADE. MAKE SURE THAT ALL OF YOUR SCHOOL AGE CHILDREN'S HOURS ARE UP TO DATE.

If you have any children that have started Kindergarten or T-K (Transitional Kindergarten) in August you will need to update their Enrollment Report information in August.

If you have any children that were ½ day kindergarten last year and will start 1st grade in August, you will need to update their Enrollment Report information.

KidKare Providers should print the existing Child Enrollment Report, make changes with an ink pen, have the parent sign and date and mail one copy to our office.



August 2021 Reimbursement is normally issued in September 2021
Checks are issued within 5 Business days of receiving the funds from CDE
Checks for late claims are issued within 5 Business days of receiving the late run funds from CDE
